Dear Anthony,

As an outcome of the Mangoola Coal Independent Environmental Audit (IEA) conducted by Hansen Baily in October 2019 and subsequent response to recommendations. Mangoola Coal has reviewed the Air Quality Management Plan required under Schedule 3, Condition 23 of PA 06\_0014 to address the below action.

Definition of 'affected landholder' is clarified with DPIE as HB would suggest landholder means "private" landholder in this context and Mangoola is assuming this is referring to any landholder,
including mine owned with tenants. This should exclude any property where predictions from another mine are predicted to exceed.

Following a meeting with the Department of Planning Industry and Environment (DPIE) in Singleton on 20 November 2019, advice was provided that Mangoola should proceed with seeking approval for the amendment to the Air Quality Management Plan in line with the recommendation.
