

Thank you for your enquiry regarding the electricity supply to proposed Stage 1 Development of Vincentia District Town Centre and we acknowledge that this project is proposed to be stages as follows:

- Stage 1 will include two supermarkets and approximately 3,220 sq.m of speciality floorspace, totalling 8,900 sq.m of leasable area, and planned to be completed in 2014.
- Stage 2 is proposed to add a discount department store of 8,000 sq.m and a further 2,600 sq.m of specialty floorspace, increasing the total centre retail floorspace to 19,500 sq.m, planned to be added at a later date as market conditions improve.

Endeavour Energy has been involved with this proposed development since about 2005 and anticipated that the total development load will eventually be feed by two 11kV feeders from adjacent Huskisson ZS. One 11kV feeder has been established and is currently supplying the development (HKH2) and the second feeder (HKA2) will eventual supply the development when freed up by the development of Tomerong TS.

Due to developing strategic plans, Endeavour Energy is now undertaking numerous projects in the Shoalhaven, Huskisson and Vincentia areas. Major projects for the establishment of West Tomerong TS and Tomerong ZS are currently under construction with completion dates schedule in 2014. This will mean that Huskisson ZS will be off loaded and constraints removed.

It is envisaged that once Endeavour Energy's approved and planned works are completed the distribution network in the vicinity will be able to support the proposed developments mature additional electrical load. It is also envisaged that loads associated with the staged development will also be able to be supported.
