

- 1.1 The Proponent shall carry out the project generally in accordance with the:
  - a) Major Project Application 06\_0028;
  - b) *Proposed Hexachlorobenzene (HCB) Waste Re-Packaging Plant, Botany Industrial Park, Environmental Assessment under Part 3A of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979, Final – Revision 0*, prepared by Orica Australia Pty Ltd and dated 18 April 2006;
  - c) Modification (06\_0028 Mod 1) of the project approval to alter air quality monitoring requirements, dated 9 January 2007;
  - d) Modification (06\_0028 Mod 2) of the project approval to rectify inconsistencies with the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 2148), dated 16 February 2009;
  - e) Modification application (06\_0028 Mod 3) with supporting documents titled *Storage of Repackaged HCB Waste at the Botany Industrial Park* prepared by Orica, dated 31 March 2009 and *Proposal to Install a Temporary Enclosure over Store H* prepared by Orica, dated 4 June 2009;
