## **SCHEDULE 1**

Approval for the construction of:

- a new Collections and Research building;
- redevelopment of the existing loading dock on William Street including widening of the driveway;
- construction of a new electrical substation within new Collections and Research building;
- demolition of early 20<sup>th</sup> century accretions of the former National School;
- reconstruction of the 1892 northern façade of the former National Schoo;.
- new accessible entrance to the west elevation of the former National School;
- adaptive re-use of the former National School for public programs, storage and staff rooms;
- the provision of landscaping works; and
- construction of infill works between Still addition and Collections and Research Building with double height exhibition at Ground level and extension of Still addition at level 2 and 3.

## **SCHEDULE 2**

The Minister's approval referred to in Schedule 1 is modified by inserting **Condition B10** as follows:

### **Condition B10**

#### **Hours of Construction**

The hours of construction, including the delivery of materials to and from the site, shall be restricted as follows:

- (1) Between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (2) Between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, Saturdays; and
- (3) No work on Sundays and public holidays.

Works may be undertaken outside these hours where:

- (1) The delivery of materials is required outside these hours by the Police or other authorities; or
- (2) It is required in an emergency to avoid the loss of life, damage to property and/or to prevent environmental harm; or
- (3) The work is approved by the Department.
