The subject property is located within a possible future area of investigation north of the Great Western Highway for an extension of the existing Werrington Arterial Stage 1 (Gipps Street). Werrington Arterial Stage 2 concept proposal provides a potential link between the current Werrington Arterial Stage 1 and the defined Castlereagh Freeway corridor to the north. The Werrington Arterial Stage 2 extension is a concept proposal and is not a current project. This proposal may be subject to future investigations which will include appropriate community consultation.
