## Re: Genesis Waste Management Facility (06\_0139 MOD 4) Invitation to Comment

Reference is made to your letter received by Council on 7 November 2013 requesting that Council review the proposed S75W modifications to the Ministerial Consent for the Genesis Waste Management Facility, specifically, increasing the operating hours for plant and equipment within the enclosed Materials Processing Centre.

Council has considered the proposal and raises no objection in principle to the proposal, subject to the following comments and conditions:

- Upon receipt of a justified complaint in relation to noise pollution emanating from the premises, an acoustical assessment is to be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Environment and Conservation's Environmental Noise Management - NSW Industrial Noise Policy and provide recommendations to mitigate the emission of offensive noise from the premises. The report shall be prepared by an appropriately qualified acoustic consultant that is a member of the Association of Australian Acoustic Consultants and shall be submitted to Council for consideration.
- 2. Any activity carried out in accordance with this approval shall not give rise to air pollution (including odour), offensive noise or pollution of land and/or water as defined by the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997.
- 3. All waste generated on the site is to be stored, handled and disposed of in such a manner as to not create air pollution (including odour), offensive noise or pollution of land and/or water as defined by the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997.
- 4. In accordance with the requirements of Part 5.7 Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997, Council is to be informed of any pollution incident that occurs in the course of carrying out the approved activity where material harm to the environment is caused or threatened.
