Please find attached a copy of the Planning Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for the preparation of a modification report for the modification application MP06_0139-Mod-9. The SEARs have been prepared in consultation with relevant public authorities based on the information you have provided to date.

Your modification application must address the SEARs (see **Attachment 1**) and the requirements of the public authorities (see **Attachment 2**). Please note the Planning Secretary may modify these requirements at any time.

If you do not submit the modification application within two years, the SEARs will expire. A written request to extend the SEARs expiry date may be made to the Planning Secretary before the expiry date.

Please contact the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (the Department) at least two weeks before you propose to submit your modification application. This will enable the Department to confirm the public exhibition arrangements.

The Department wishes to emphasise the importance of effective and genuine community consultation. A comprehensive open and transparent community consultation engagement process <u>must</u> be undertaken during the preparation of the modification application. This process must ensure that the community is provided with a good understanding of what is proposed (including a description of any potential impacts) and they are actively engaged in issues of concern to them.

If you're the modification is likely to have a significant impact on matters of National Environmental Significance, it will require an approval under the Commonwealth *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act). This approval would be in addition to any approvals required under NSW legislation and it is your responsibility to contact the Commonwealth Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment to determine if an approval under the EPBC Act is required (http://www.environment.gov.au or 6274 1111).
