






# Legend


Permanent farm style timber post and wire fence pedestrian access through fence gaps and bollards will be installed to control pedestrian movement where desired. Vehicular access gained through padlocked gates for maintenance purposes.

Temporary timber and star picket combination fence with 3- 4 strand wire. Gates to be installed to correspond where access is required for maintenance. Fencing will be progressively removed as each civil construction stage ceases

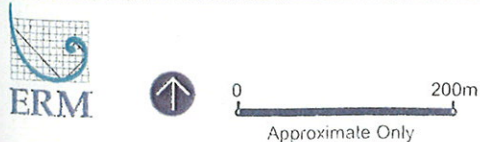
\* Pedestrian access point to link the western urban area to the east
