The site is owned by the Sydney Olympic Park Authority and is located within the Town Centre Precinct of Olympic Park on the corner of Australia Avenue and Murray Rose Avenue.

The above approval is modified as follows:

- (a) Delete Condition B1(1)(a)
- (b) Delete Condition B1(3).

(c) Delete Condition B11 and replace with the following

Condition B11 – Number of Car Spaces

The maximum number of car spaces to be provided for the development shall comply with the table below. Details confirming the parking numbers shall be submitted to the satisfaction of the Certifying Authority prior to the issue of a Construction Certificate.

* Retail parking spaces provided are to be a minimum of 1 car parking space per retail tenancy.

(d) Delete Condition B12 and replace with the following:

Condition B12 – Number of Bicycle Spaces

A minimum number of 31 bicycle spaces are associated with the development including 21 located in the basement car parking area and 10 located along Murray Rose Avenue adjacent to the building. Details shall be submitted to the satisfaction of the Certifying Authority prior to the issue of a Construction Certificate

(e) Delete Condition F13(4) and replace with the following:

Condition F13(4) – Parking and Traffic Management

A 20m signposted SHORT TERM loading bay is to be provided within the rear service lane to the east of the car spaces adjacent to the rear building wall.

(f) Delete Condition F13(6).
