These reports shall be consistent with guidelines made or approved by the EPA under Section 105 of the *Contaminated Land Management Act 1997*.

10. Insert new condition 66:

66. Validation reports prepared under condition 65 shall be reviewed by the Site Auditor. Site Audit Statement(s) and Summary Site Audit Report(s) shall be prepared by the Site Auditor certifying whether the remedial works within each stage and/ or area of the site have been carried out in accordance with the approved RAWPs, the conditions of this approval and any recommendations made the Site Auditor, and whether the remediated part of the site is suitable for its intended land use.

11. Insert new condition 67:

67. Validation reports and associated Site Audit Statements and Summary Audit Reports shall be prepared for the Incitec site, and be submitted to the Director-General and the EPA. No land within the Incitec site shall be sold or released for development unless approval of the validation report and associated Site Audit Report and Statement for that land have been obtained from the Director-General and the EPA.
