Shoalhaven Starches Ethanol Expansion Project Modification 17 (06 0226-MOD-17)

The Department of Planning, Infrastructure and Environment has completed its assessment of the merits of the modification application for the Shoalhaven Starches Ethanol Expansion Project Modification 17 (06_0228-MOD-17)

In accordance with the Minister's delegation dated 9 March 2020, the application is referred to the Independent Planning Commission for determination, as a political donation has been made by the applicant.

The Department did not exhibit the application and accompanying Statement of Environmental Effects (SEE) but made the application publicly available on the Department's website on 13 January 2020 and referred it to Shoalhaven City Council and public authorities for comment.

In assessing the merits of the application, the Department considered the environmental, social and economic impacts of the modification, submissions on the SEE, relevant environmental planning instruments, the suitability of the site for the development, and the public interest, in accordance with the EP&A Act.

Based on its assessment, the Department believes that the modification application is approvable subject to modified conditions.
