Comment by NSW Office of Water

The NSW Office of Water has considered the proposal in terms of its statutory obligations under the Water Management Act 2000 and has no objection to the modifications proposed.

The Environmental Assessment (EA) indicates some minor changes to water supply sources via the capture of up to 1ML of additional rainfall runoff which will occur from the modifications to the site layout. However, the drawing of water from the Willeroo Borefield remains the primary water source for the operation. The water

demands and supplies for the modified processing operations identified, remain within the company's existing licensed entitlement.

The EA also indicates some modifications to existing water infrastructure being a reduction in the capacity of the leachate storage dam and a 0.5 ML increase in the capacity of the stormwater dam (to 5.0 ML). Again, these modifications are considered minor and do not require any licensing action.
