Cadia Holdings Pty Limited has submitted an application to modify its project approval for the Cadia East Gold/Copper Project.

The proposed modification involves increasing the approved ore processing rate at the mine from 27 million tonnes a year to 32 million tonnes a year.

This would be achieved by upgrading and/or constructing additional crushing, grinding and flotation facilities, and increasing the capacity of product trains. A temporary mobile crusher would be installed during construction of these facilitates, and temporary trucking would be used until conveyors are installed.

There would be no change to the approved disturbance footprint, or the approved mining methods.
