#### Tooheys Brewery Upgrade Lidcombe (06\_0303 MOD 1) Director General's Requirements

I refer to your request to modify the project approval for the Tooheys Brewery Upgrade, Lidcombe to include a 2MW Co-generation Facility at the brewery. The Department understands that the project would include the installation of a gas fired internal combustion engine with 2WM of electrical energy output. The new plant would be substantially installed inside the existing engine room with the exception of a cooling tower and exhaust silencer which would be installed outside below the current roofline.

The modification application is to be assessed and determined under section 75W of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.* As such you are requested to complete the attached application form and make payment to the amount of \$750 to the Department for the processing of the modification application.

I have attached a copy of the Director-General's requirements for the environmental assessment of the proposed modification. Please note that under section 75F(3) of the EP&A Act the Director-General may alter these requirements at any time.
