I therefore request an extension of time to be placed on the public display with a clear address stated for the public to respond. Advice to the update and amendment should also be advised publicly.

I would like to offer comment to the proposed mine for the following reasons:-

1/ The proposed mine is right in the heart of an established residential community, for this reason alone, should be rejected.

2/ Noise pollution although the applicants have shown attempts to reduce as much as possible, there will still be affects from noise.

3/ Dust and airborne polutants, are a common problem and as much as the applicants propose using spray supressants, will not completely negate this problem.

4/ The closest residents to the mine lease already have highly contaminated soils and subject to adverse health effects.

5/ The history of Broken Hill has proven that the mining industry will cut corners to reduce costs, the effects of lead and polluted waters in the district is testimony to this.

6/ Noise pollution levels and accepted levels of noise differ from previous submissions (re submission 2009 stage 1 CBH) which indicate conflicting measurements quoted. I request a re evaluation assessing previous measurements with present quoted figures.
