Re Broken Hill Rasp mine – MOD 5

I refer to your electronic mail dated 7 September 2018 to the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) about our comments on the Broken Hill Operations Pty Ltd (BHOP) Rasp mine Statement of Environmental Effects prepared for the proposed MOD 5 of SSD 9597.

The EPA has reviewed the proposed development consent amendments to the stores warehouse and cement silo and has no objections to the proposals.

We note the silo is fitted with a filter and we recommend that BHOP ensure that the filter is included in the relevant air quality monitoring maintenance program.

We also understand;

- that Shaft 6 (EPA point 56) has changed from an exhaust shaft to a clean air intake shaft meaning monitoring is not required and,
- that BHOP have requested that crusher baghouse stack monitoring is included in the project approval.
