It is therefore requested that the MCoA 1.6 be modified to allow sufficient time to prepare, assess and approve the necessary staging works to enable practical commencement of the proposed ancillary sites by November 2009. The proposed modification seeks a reduction of the stated 8 weeks to '4 weeks, or at the discretion of the Director-General'.

The RTA considers the changes would be consistent with current timeframes requested on a number of other conditions by the DoP. RTA also acknowledges the importance of the establishment of the ancillary site to allow better management of the early works, preparation for the commencement of substantial construction and more efficient use of project and public funding.
