## **Description of proposal**

Construction and operation of an up to 150 megawatt open cycle distillate-fired power station near Buronga in the Wentworth local government area. The electricity generated at the power station would be fed into the electricity transmission network via the existing TransGrid high voltage switching station located immediately adjacent to the proposed plant site.

#### Application of Part 3A

On 1 August 2007, the Director-General as delegate for the Minister for Planning formed the opinion that the project is a development of a kind described in Schedule 1 of *State Environmental Planning Policy (Major Projects) 2005* and is therefore a project to which Part 3A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* applies. Consequently, the Minister for Planning is the approval authority for the project.
