Dear Lauren Evans,

Council has no objection to the proposed modification to allow SCCCQR Quarries to import up to 200,000 tonnes of VENM and/or Excavated Natural Material (ENM) per year for blending/rehabilitation purposes. This is subject to the operator complying, where applicable, with the EPA's Resource Recovery Order Under Part 9, Clause 93 of the POEO (Waste) Regulation 2014, being the "The excavated natural material order 2014".

In addition, Council's Environmental Services have noted that Council has in the past and continue to have concerns about sediment being tracked onto the highway from this premises. Nearby commercial premises have also complained about dust coming from the quarry. These concerns have been passed on to the EPA as they come up.

South Coast Concrete Crushing and Recycling Quarries (SCCCR Quarries) has submitted a modification application for the Nowra Brickworks Quarry Project, in the Shoalhaven City local government area.

The current project approval allows SCCCQR Quarries to import up to 200,000 tonnes of Virgin Excavated Natural Material (VENM) per year for blending/rehabilitation purposes. The proposed modification would allow SCCCQR Quarries to import up to 200,000 tonnes of VENM **and/or Excavated Natural Material (ENM)** per year for blending/rehabilitation purposes.
