FOOTPATH RESTORATION Intersection of Smith and Belgrave Streets

Kempsey Shire Council will be undertaking footpath resotration in Smith Street on the intersection of Smith and Belgrave Streets (in front of the Westnac Bank).

As part of this construction, it is proposed to replace current pavers with a coated ashphalt surface commencing Saturday 15 November 2008 at 1 pm. The initial work is expected to be completed on Sunday 16 November 2008 (subject to fine weather) and temporary pedestrian facilities will be installed, until the night time asphalt work is completed. While most work is scheduled to be completed outside normal CBD trading hours it may be necessary to schedule some minor work during trading hours.

There will be minimal disruption to vehicle traffic while the work is in progress, however traffic delays in peak periods heading east on Belgrave Street can be expected and motorists are advised to use alternative routes to avoid the intersection
