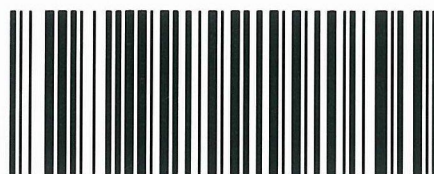

Dear Mr Ritchie

I refer to your letter dated 14 December 2012 requesting the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) make a submission on the proposed modification (No. 08\_0016 Mod 1) of an existing premises at 133 - 145 Lenore Drive, Erskine Park.

On review of the supporting documentation the EPA has determined that under Part 1 (Premises Based Activities) Section 9 (Chemical storage) of the Schedule 1 of *the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (POEO) the premises will not require an Environment Protection Licence because the proposed maximum chemical and dangerous goods storage capacity of premises is below the threshold of 2,000 tonnes. Accordingly, EPA has no further interest in the matter.
