## SECTION 75W - MODIFICATION OF MINISTER'S APPROVAL

Reference is made to the Major Project determination MP08\_0098 and conditions of approval issued by the Minister for Planning on 27 January 2009 and as subsequently modified for the above development.

On behalf of Echo Entertainment, APP Corporation Pty Ltd are submitting this request to modify the Minister's approval under section 75W of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act, 1979* (EP&A Act). This application seeks to modify the approved external façade material of the Multi Use Entertainment Facility (MUEF).

The current approved facade material for the MUEF "GEM" facade is stainless steel sheeting in long rectilinear strips formed within the main triangulated geometry of the GEM. The proposed material of translucent glass will afford a greater quality of finish for the MUEF and express the original concept for the gemstone design.

This section 75W modification does not change the intent of the Minister's approval and is consistent with the existing approval. An environmental assessment report is not considered necessary due to the minor nature of the modification which is not expected to cause adverse impacts on neighbouring properties or the streetscape. Reflectivity of the materials remains below the required 20% and external lighting of the MUEF façade is not proposed. Any future proposal for lighting will be the subject of a development application to the City of Sydney.
