Alterations and additions to Building F;

Construction of a new four storey building with basement parking for 62 47 cars; and

Associated landscaping works.

Condition 9 is amended by the deletion of the struck out words and the insertion of the following bold underlined words:

(9) MATERIALS AND SAMPLE BOARD

A materials and sample board detailed all proposed finishes, colours and glazing must be submitted for the approval of Council prior to a Construction Certificate for relevant building works being issued.

Any changes to the materials and finishes approved in Condition 2B shall be approved by the Director General prior to the issue of a Construction Certificate for the relevant building works.

Condition 10 is amended by the following bold underlined words:

(10) SIGNS - SEPARATE DA REQUIRED

A separate development application for any proposed signs (other than exempt or complying signs under Council's exempt and complying DCPs) <u>other than the approved</u> <u>digital screen</u> must be submitted to and approved by Council prior to the erection or display of any such signs.

Condition 11 is added:

(11) DIGITAL SCREEN

The digital screen shall:

- (a) only operate or be illuminated between the hours of 8:00am to 10:00pm Monday to Saturday and 9:00am to 9:00pm on Sunday;
- (b) not provide any animated images (this requirement can be varied if approved by the Roads and Traffic Authority, in consultation with the Department of Planning & Infrastructure);
- (c) not provide any flashing images; and
- (d) shall not be used for the purposes of an advertisement as defined by State Environmental Policy 64 – Advertising and Signage.

Condition 15 is amended by the deletion of the struck out words and the insertion of the following bold underlined words:

(15) CAR PARKING SPACES AND DIMENSIONS

A maximum of 78 <u>60</u> off-street car parking spaces must be provided. The design, layout, signage, line marking, lighting and physical controls of all off-street parking facilities must comply with the minimum requirements of Australian Standard AS/NZS 2890.1 - 2004 Parking facilities Part 1: Off-street car parking and Council's Development Control Plan. The details must be submitted to and approved by the Principal Certifying Authority prior to a Construction Certificate for relevant building works being issued.
