## AUSTAR COAL PROJECT - MODIFICATION 3 of PA08\_0111

I refer to the Environmental Assessment (EA) exhibited on the NSW Department of Planning & Infrastructure website in relation to the Austar Coal Modification 3 – Longwalls Extension.

The development is a modification to the 2008 Project Approval 08\_0111 and involves extending longwalls A7 to A10 in the Austar Coal Mine Stage 3 mining area by 100 to 300 metres. The mine is located approximately 10 kilometres south of Cessnock.

The EA has been reviewed by Hunter New England Population Health with particular attention paid to management of air quality, noise, water and other issues that may impact on public health. Due to the modification having no changes to surface facilities, operations, employment and production rates, Hunter New England Local Health District is satisfied with existing approval conditions.
