SCHEDULE 2

1. In the list of definitions in schedule 1, delete the definitions for "DITRIS" and "RTA" and insert the following in alphabetical order:

- 2. Replace all references to "RTA" in Schedule 3 of this approval with "RMS".
- 3. Replace references to "OEH" in Schedule 3, conditions 9, 16, 22 and 34 of this approval with "EPA".
- 4. In condition 2 of schedule 2, delete all words after "EA (MOD 1);" and insert the following:
 - (c) EA (MOD 2);
 - (d) statement of commitments; and
 - (e) conditions of this approval.

5. Delete condition 10 of schedule 3, and replace with the following:

Operational Blasting Criteria

10. The Proponent shall ensure that operational blasting on site does not cause exceedances of the criteria in Table 7.

- 6. After condition 10 of schedule 3, insert the following:
 - 10A. The Proponent shall ensure that both operational blasting and construction blasting on the site does not damage Heritage Sites on site. Heritage Sites can be identified in Appendix 7 of this approval.
- 7. Delete condition 11 of schedule 3, and replace with the following:

Operational Blasting Hours

- 11. The Proponent shall only carry out operational blasting on site between 9am and 5pm Monday to Saturday inclusive. No operational blasting is allowed on Sundays, public holidays, or at any other time without the written approval of Director-General.
- 8. Delete condition 12 of schedule 3, and replace with the following:

Operational Blasting Frequency

12. The Proponent shall not carry out more than 1 operational blast a day on site, unless an additional operational blast is required following a blast misfire.

Note: A blast may involve a number of explosions within a short period, typically less than two minutes.

9. After condition 12 of schedule 3, insert the following:

Construction Blasting Hours and Frequency

- 12A. The Proponent shall only carry out construction blasting on site between 7am and 7pm daily where the Proponent confirms by design and prediction prior to construction blasting that the overpressure and vibration levels will be less than 95dB(A) and 1mm/sec, respectively at all private buildings.
- 6. In condition 41 of schedule 3, move the reference to 3 kilometres of cliffline from the Bobadeen Vegetation Offset Area column to the Brokenback Conservation Area column.
- 7. Delete Appendices 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7 and replace with:
