Location + Design Statement



_Pacific Motorway

This Landscape Statement of Intent has been prepared on behalf of Project 28 Pty. Ltd. for the proposed intersection and improvments at Tweed Coast Road and Kings Forest Parkway. The design intent for the proposed changes to Tweed Coast Road is to provide a functioning, high quality environment which will integrate within the existing context and mitigate the disturbance of the proposed service station on Precinct 1, Lot 7 DP875447. The concept will:

- Minimise the impact on neighbouring properties by providing a 2.5m high acoustic fence with tree planting in median strip and verge which will provide upper level screening and softening, privacy and shade. •
- Maximise tree and low groundcover planting to median strip and verge to provide shade and reduce the harshness of sealed surfaces. •
- Provide a well considered plant selection to ensure low maintenance and that the landscape complies with Austroads Guides by using trees with clean stemmed trunks planted in association with native ground covers not • exceeding .7 metre in height.
