Supplementary Response to Submissions (RtS)**

Thank you for your email dated 9 August 2019 forwarding supplementary Response to Submissions (RtS) to Roads and Maritime Services for further comment.

Roads and Maritime acknowledges the incorrect reference to Schedule 3 Condition 11 and Condition 12 in our RtS dated 02 August 2019, noting the correct reference is Schedule 3 Condition 12 and Condition 13 respectively.

Noting the Lidsdale Siding Construction Management Plan (CTMP) was developed in consultation with Lithgow City Council and Roads and Maritime and approved by the then Director General in 2015.

Further to the above as noted in email correspondence via James Wearne (Centennial Coal) to yourself on 09 August 2019 stating the expected traffic during construction would comprise:

- Four (4) Oversize / Over length loads for the transportation of the radial stacker elements. Noting additional permits would be required for the transportation of these loads which would be sought ahead of works commencing.
- Nominally ten (10) other normal loads (non-oversize), consisting of containerised conveyor elements will also be sent to site.
- The delivery campaign is expected to go over a few weeks, and the oversize elements are expected to be sent in two separate lots.



Further to this as noted in correspondence from Mr Wearne in the supplementary RtS on 09 August 2019 that a review of the CTMP identifies that the management measures to deal with traffic impacts associated with the proposal remain relevant and that a new CTMP is not considered necessary for the small volume of construction traffic that would be generated by this modification should it be approved.

Roads and Maritime does not object to the proposed modification having received clarification by way of the supplementary RtS received.
