I refer to your letter dated 25 August 2010 inviting a submission from the NSW Rural Fire Service (RFS) regarding bush fire protection for the above proposal.

Based on the information provided the RFS recommends the following advice and conditions:

- 1. At the commencement of building works and in perpetuity, a 20 metre minimum asset protection zone adjoining the northern boundary within Cudgen Reserve shall be maintained an inner protection area (IPA) as outlined within Appendices 2 & 5 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006' and the NSW Rural Fire Service's document 'Standards for asset protection zones'.
- 2. Water, electricity and gas supplies are to be installed in accordance with sections 4.1.3 and 4.2.7 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006'.
- 3. An emergency and evacuation plan is to be prepared in accordance with section 4.2.7 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006'.
- The proposed building shall be constructed to comply with section 5 (BAL 12.5)
   Australian Standard AS3959-2009 'Construction of buildings in bush fire-prone areas' and section A3.7 Addendum Appendix 3 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006'.

5. Landscaping to the site is to comply with the principles of Appendix 5 of 'Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006'.
