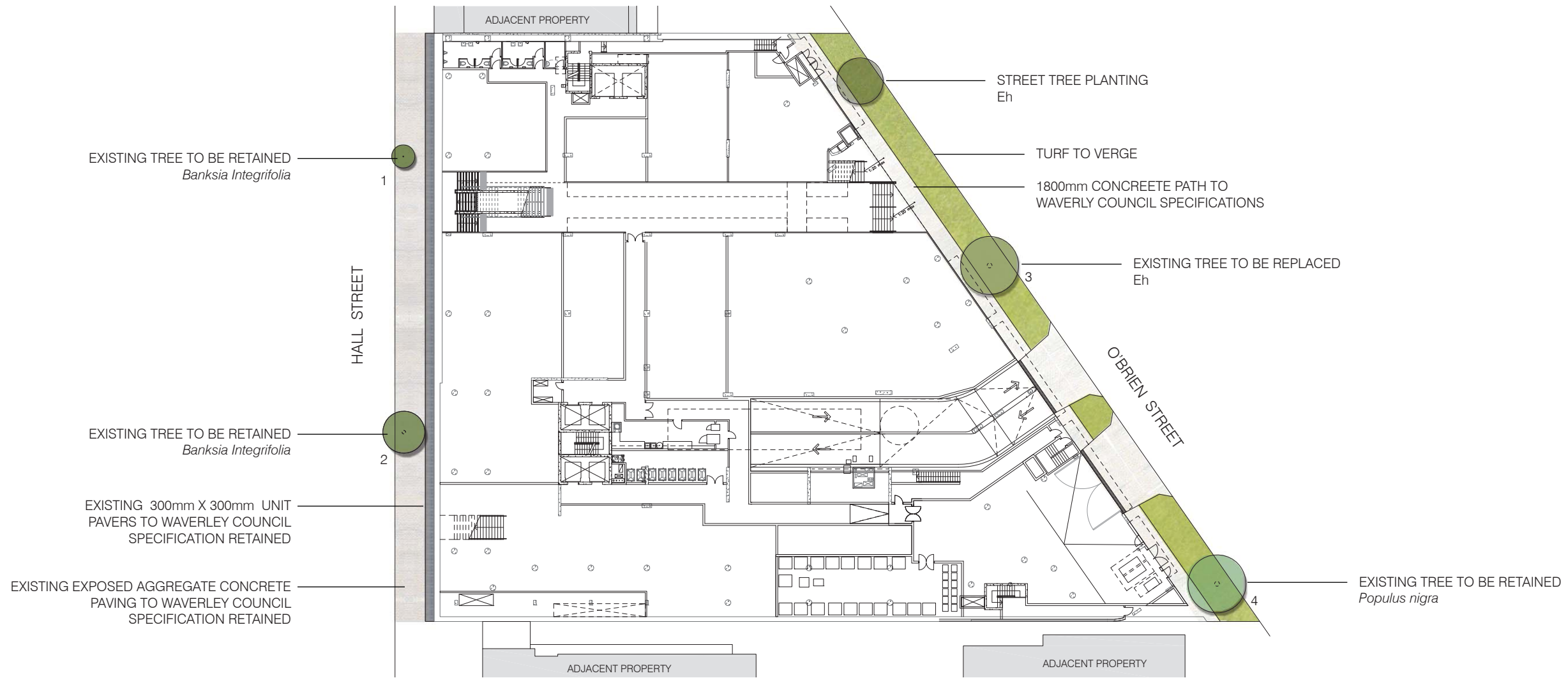

PROPOSED LANDSCAPE



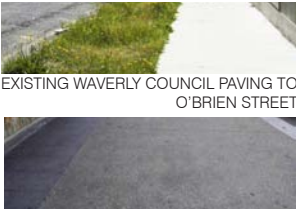
PROPOSED TREE: *Eucalyptus haemastona*

DESIGN INTENT  
Low use residential street with large sized evergreen tree. Evergreen tree will provide year round canopy and reflect the adjacent existing planting.

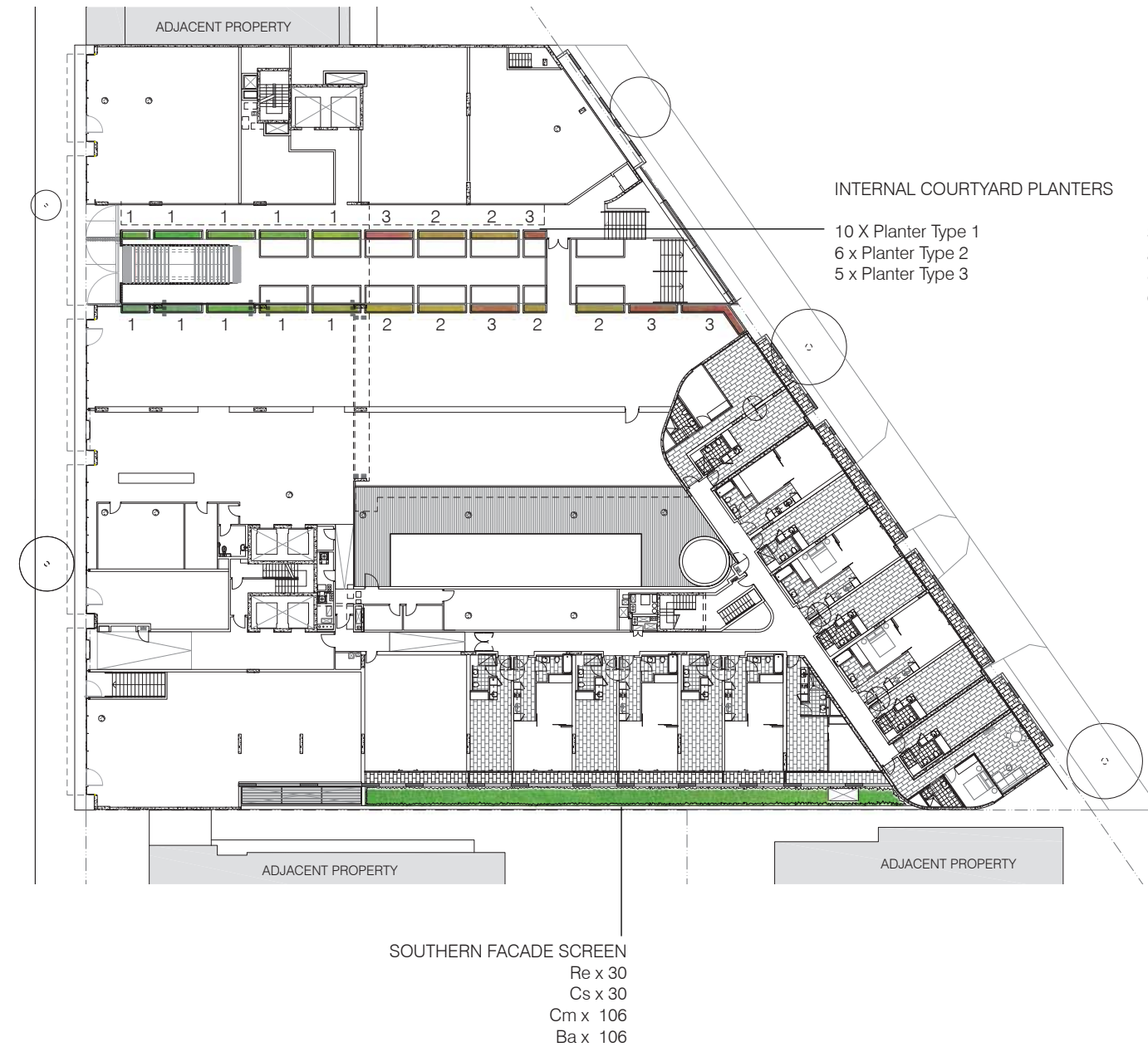

DESIGN INTENT - INTERNAL COURTYARD PLANTERS

Species overhang planters creating lush & delicate greenery amongst a highly used civic space. Sun tolerant species add colour & texture to the open courtyard while lush green foliage cascades over planters in enclosed spaces.

DESIGN INTENT - SOUTHERN FACADE SCREEN

Lush Raphis & Bamboo palms screen the south western facade. A colourful mix of clivia & bromeliads provide colour & detail to the under storey.
