RE: MP_09_0167 – Mixed Use Development at 45 Macquarie St cnr 140 Marsden Street, Parramatta – Condition D27 of the Approval

Reference is made to your emails dated 5 April and 23 April 2012 (revised plans) which relate to Conditions A14 and D27 of the approval. The Conditions state:

A14. Archaeological Excavation Methodology.

All affected areas within the site, which are of historical archaeological significance and will be affected by the construction works are to be subject to professional archaeological excavation methodology that must be prepared in accordance with Heritage Council NSW guidelines for each site which is to be excavated. Those documents should be prepared for the approval of the Director, Heritage Branch prior to the release of any construction Certificate.

Correspondence was previously issued by the Heritage Branch dated 12 December 2011 regarding the satisfaction of Condition A14 and the issue of a Construction Certificate.

D27. Protection of Archaeology

Significant archaeological heritage items and remnant built fabric elements are to be adequately protected during the works from potential damage. Protection systems must ensure historic fabric is not damaged or removed.

The Heritage Branch has reviewed the report forwarded with your email regarding D27: *Proposed Protection Methodology for Archaeological Remains During Construction.* 45-47 Macquarie Street & 134-140 Marsden Street, Parramatta, N.S.W.' prepared by Edward Higginbotham and Associates for Crown Landmark Pty Ltd, April 2012.

The above report is considered by the Heritage Branch to provide appropriate methodologies for the protection of the archaeological remains during construction of the new development. The Heritage Branch also understands that a modification to the development is to be lodged shortly.
