Woodlawn Bioreactor Site Modification (MP 10_0012 Mod 1 and DA Q91/00233 Mod 2)

I refer to your email dated 8 January 2016 to the Department of Primary Industries in respect to the above matter. Comment has been sought from DPI Water, Fisheries and Agriculture. Comment by DPI Water

DPI Water has reviewed the proposed modification to the Woodlawn Bioreactor site and provides the following comments:

- The proposed modification to the use of existing ponds for the management of leachate under Section 75W of the EP&A Act does not require a Works and Use Approval under the Water Management Act 2000.
- ED3S evaporation dam is to be lined appropriately to limit any potential contamination of groundwater or surface water sources.
- The proposed modification to the use of existing evaporation dams ED2 and ED3S is unlikely to result in any further significant impact to surrounding surface and groundwater sources.
