

CHRONOLOGY - MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY CONCEPT PLAN APPROVAL CONDITION C15(1) RTA / RMS AGREEMENT

The following table provides a chronology of actions initiated or undertaken by Macquarie University to seek to satisfy Condition C15(1) of the Concept Plan approval, now Condition E1 of the Australian Hearing Hub approval.

Relevant intersections listed in Condition B3(1) as well as potential extent of cycleway upgrades. Condition B5 also sets out potential need for setbacks on Balaclava and Waterloo Roads and bus priority measures prior to any new building works in Precinct E. Under Condition C10(4), micro-simulation modelling as required by C10(2) is required to form part of the MQU/RMS agreement.

Bus priority measures / setbacks on Waterloo Road near Herring Road within the University. The payment of funds for the infrastructure upgrades, and the 'pooling' of funds from other developments.
