Results from archaeological excavations undertaken in the local area on similar landforms by Navin Officer in 2007 indicate that it is unlikely that subsurface archaeological deposits are present at the site, and that archaeological material is limited to a surface scatter of stone artefacts. As such, further archaeological investigation of this site, including archaeological excavation, is unlikely to increase the current scientific knowledge of the region. However, the proposed construction of a substation and associated access road will directly impact on artefacts, and as such, the Aboriginal community should be offered the opportunity to collect and relocate artefacts outside of the construction area prior to works beginning.</p>
