

Record of Minister's opinion for the purposes of Clause 6(1) of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Major Development) 2005

I, the Deputy Director-General of the Department of Planning, as delegate of the Minister for Planning under delegation executed on 4 March 2009, have formed the opinion that the development described in the Schedule below, is development of a kind that is described in Schedule 1 of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Major Development) 2005 - namely Clause 5(1)(a) "development for the purpose of mining that has a capital investment value of more than \$30 million" - and is thus declared to be a project to which Part 3A of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 applies for the purpose of section 75B of that Act.
