None of the utilities involved seemed to have very accurate maps.Recently Bill Potter, from the SCC, was investigating a leak into Riley St., and I believe was unable to establish where it came from. Please could you investigate this situation, as we need to ensure that there is not major disruption to house foundations and flooding to the area?
