I was strongly against the sale of Greythwaite to Shore School. It represents vandalism by the NSW State Government and is against the principles of the Dibb Trust.

Currently I oppose the development outlined in the EAR based on the planned loss of historic trees, lack of public access, and the likely heavy traffic load in the area, particularly in the only access road to our house - the southern end of Edward St.

I urge the Department of Planning to hold a public inquiry into this development. In particular, I would urge Shore School to provide permanent public access to at least part of the site. I believe that their statement on page 13 of the EAR that "Shore?s duty of care to its students (including 198 boarders) and staff precludes unrestricted public access to the Graythwaite site" is contrary to their earlier discussions with Council and the Community and represents an unacceptable locking up of what should have been valuable public space.
