## Part 3A Major Project Declaration Request: 2-32 Smith Street, Summer Hill – Former Allied Mills Flour Mill site

Dear Director-General,

We are writing on behalf of EG Funds Management, the proponent and for the development of 2-32 Smith Street, Summer Hill.

The purpose of this letter is to request that:

- (a) The Minister for Planning form an opinion that the proposal is development of a kind described in Group 5 in Schedule 1 of *State Environmental Planning Policy (Major Development) 2005*;
- (b) Subject to the Minister forming the opinion that the project is one to which Part 3A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act 1979)* applies, that the Minister authorise the proponent to submit a Concept Plan Application for the missed use redevelopment of the land together with a concurrent Project Application for the development of stage one; and
- (c) That the Director-General issues the requirements for the preparation of an Environmental Assessment to accompany the Concept Plan and Project Application for the proposed development.

To assist the Minister in forming the opinion that the proposal is of a kind to which Part 3A applies and the preparation of the Director-General Requirements (DGRs), a Preliminary Environmental Assessment (PEA) has been prepared and is attached to this request.

The PEA has been undertaken with the benefit and guidance of a detailed site masterplan prepared by Hassell.

This detailed Concept Plan has been developed over a significant period of time and informed through detailed technical studies and engagement with the community and the two local councils (Ashfield and Marrickville). Note that the land proposed to be covered by the Concept Plan is located within Ashfield and Marrickville Councils, with the holdings straddling the administrative boundary between these two Council areas.

The PEA and site masterplan is supported by numerous technical assessments undertaken in the preparation of a Planning Proposal proposing the rezoning of the site to Zone B4 Mixed Use. These investigations have been progressed to a detail well beyond a preliminary assessment of the proposal and have been utilised to inform the preparation of this Concept Plan and will underpin the detailed assessment and consideration of the proposed Concept Plan and Project Plan applications for the site.
