Nice to speak to you today.

As discussed, we have a development application currently with the NSW Department of Planning for assessment. The subject site is the former Renaissance Herb Farm / Nursery; I have attached a plan and photo showing the site. Our proposed development includes basement car parking underneath a Woolworths supermarket, Big W and specialty stores. We also propose building roads and civic square for community use.
