Hi Stephanie

Attached is the map I use with each mooring position plotted by GPS - not always totally accurate but gives an indication of the moorings relative to each other.

CL5517 are 2 poles associated with the current jetty at the proposed development site. The red dot next to it is a navigation marker - it marks the extent of the poles and is no problem to move. MV125X is a cancelled mooring which is for sale and can be moved at any time to wherever I please.

Any private moorings which require re-location for the proposed development can be simply shifted but it is always best to service them when doing so. Private moorings are licensed to individuals and a condition is they can be moved for whatever reason Maritime sees fit. I intend to inspect the area this week as I have returned from leave and I will identify any moorings I believe need moving and will let you know. I will also be talking to the developer about this so he is aware of any costs which he may be subject to if moorings are re-located.
