D3. **Construction Hours**

The hours of construction, including the delivery of materials to and from the Subject Site, shall be restricted as follows:

- between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, Mondays to Fridays inclusive. a)
- between 8:00 am and 1:00 pm, Saturdays. b)
- c) no work on Sundays and public holidays.
- d) Works may be undertaken outside these hours where:
 - i. the delivery of materials is required outside these hours by the Police or other authorities;
 - ii. it is required in an emergency to avoid the loss of life, damage to property and/or to prevent environmental harm; or
 - iii. when approved in advance in writing by the Director General or his nominee.
- Notwithstanding parts (a), (b), (c) and (d), works may be undertaken outside these hours on not more than three (3) single day occurrences, between 6am and 7pm, Mondays to Fridays, to facilitate necessary concrete pours.

The Proponent is required to take necessary measures to notify Council, surrounding residences and hospital users, at least 48 hours prior to this occurring.
