No Comment to Planning Advice Request

Dear Prity,

Thank you for the request for advice from Public Authority Consultation (PAE-10940745), requesting input from the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the proposed upgrades to the Sydney Grammar School's Weigall Sports Complex (Application SSD 10421) at Neild Avenue, Rushcutters Bay NSW.

The EPA has previously stated on 24 January 2020 that the EPA has no comments to make on the proposal and no follow up consultation is required.

Based on the information provided, the proposal does not appear to require an environment protection licence under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*. Furthermore, the EPA understands that the proposal is not being undertaken by or on behalf of a NSW Public Authority nor are the proposed activities other activities for which the EPA is the appropriate regulatory authority.

In view of these factors, the EPA has no comments to provide on this project and no follow-up consultation is required.

The EPA does not require any follow-up consultation and Woollahra Municipal Council should be consulted as the appropriate regulatory authority for the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* in relation to the proposal.
