Advice on EIS and recommended conditions – State Significant Development – Saint Ignatius' College Riverview Redevelopment Stage 2 (SSD 10424)

Thank you for your referral uploaded to the Major Projects Portal on 12 November 2020 seeking advice on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) report and recommended conditions for the above state significant development (SSD) proposal.

In preparing the following advice we have reviewed the following documents:

- SEARs for SSD-10424, issued 5 February 2020
- Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report (ACHAR) prepared by Comber Consultants, dated 30 September 2020
- Environmental Impact Statement SSD 10424 Saint Ignatius' College prepared by Willow Tree Planning Pty Ltd, dated 11 November 2020

It is noted that there are 6 Aboriginal sites registered on the Aboriginal Heritage Information Management System located within the report study area. None of these sites are located within the area of proposed works and therefore no impacts to Aboriginal Cultural Heritage (ACH) values have been identified. The ACHAR has been prepared in reference to the relevant guidelines as required by the SEARs (Requirement 11).

The management and mitigation recommendations provided in Chapter 9.0 (page 34) of the ACHAR and Section 7.6 (page 68) of the EIS are considered to provide appropriate provisions for the conservation of ACH values in the study area. It is recommended that these recommendations are incorporated into Appendix I of the EIS: Draft Management and Mitigation Measures.
