**DA251-09-01-MOD-14- GINGKO MINE MOD14 – PROPOSED EXTENSION OF EXISTING EXTRACTION PITS, GINGKO MINERAL SANDS MINE PROJECT, NOB ROAD, WENTWORTH.**

I refer to your correspondence regarding the subject Application which was referred to Transport for NSW (TfNSW), for assessment and comment.

From the information provided it is understood the proposal represents a modification to allow for the expansion of the Ginkgo Mineral sands mine project to accommodate an extension of the life mine from March 2023 to December 2025. The application is supported by an Assessment Report dated November 2020.

The modification represents an extension of the life of the mine but does not propose any change to the traffic generation resultant from the Mine operation as there would be no change to mineral concentrate and MSP process waste transport rates or the size of the Ginkgo Mine workforce. As a result, the typical weekday traffic generated by development and its distribution on the surrounding road network is expected to remain the same for the duration of the Modification.

Based on the above it is considered that the proposed modification would not represent any significant impacts on the performance, capacity, efficiency or safety of the road network. Therefore Transport for NSW advises that no objection is raised to the proposed modification.
