Dear Mr Fetterplace, Subject: Modification 3 – Cahill Expressway Access Ramp (SSD 7037) (City of Sydney)

I refer to your e-mail dated 3 December 2019 requesting comments from the Environment, Energy and Science Group (EES) in the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment on Modification 3 – Cahill Expressway Access Ramp.

It is noted that the modification seeks approval for a pedestrian ramp adjacent to the southern boundary of the site linking Gloucester Street and the Cahill Expressway. It is noted that a public lift was included within the SSD 7037 SEARs request but was ultimately excluded from the scheme due to the complexities in negotiating with Roads and Maritime Services at the time.

Aboriginal Cultural Heritage

If the Department determines to grant approval, EES recommends that any conditions recommended by the Aboriginal and Historical Archaeological Assessment prepared by Urbis dated 11 November 2019 be included as conditions of consent.
