## Oakdale West Estate Stage 3 Development (SSD-9794683) EIS

I refer to your email of 16 February 2021 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) Water and the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR) about the above matter.

The following recommendations are provided by NRAR.

## Post Approval

- All take of water from groundwater and/or surface water sources (including induced groundwater inflows) should be appropriately licenced under a water access licence (WAL) prior to the take of water commencing.
- For any licensable water take requiring a meter, the meter should be a type that is compliant with the NSW non-urban water metering Policy <a href="https://www.industry.nsw.gov.au/\_data/assets/pdf\_file/0017/312335/nsw-non-urban-water-metering-policy.pdf">https://www.industry.nsw.gov.au/\_data/assets/pdf\_file/0017/312335/nsw-non-urban-water-metering-policy.pdf</a>
