**Liddell Battery and Bayswater Ancillary Works (SSD-8889679)
EIS**

I refer to your email of 8 April 2021 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) Water and the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR) about the above matter.

This project proposes to construct and operate a Battery Energy Storage System, decouple Liddell and Bayswater power stations, facilitate the improved safety, reliability, efficiency and environmental performance of Bayswater Power Station.

The following recommendations are provided by DPIE Water and NRAR.

Post Approval

- The proposal should ensure that the works located on waterfront land are completed in accordance with NRAR's guidelines for controlled activities on waterfront land and consider setbacks and offsetting requirements detailed in the guideline - https://www.industry.nsw.gov.au/_data/assets/pdf_file/0004/156865/NRAR-Guidelines-for-controlled-activities-on-waterfront-land-Riparian-corridors.pdf.
- Water take under existing water access licences must be appropriately metered where the rules apply.
