Thank you for your referral dated 28 April 2021 inviting comments from the Heritage Council of NSW on the above State Significant Development proposal.

The subject site at 657 – 769 Mamre Road, Kemps Creek is not listed on the State Heritage Register (SHR), nor is it near any SHR items. Whilst it is acknowledged that the historical archaeological assessment (*Mamre South State Significant Development Application – Statement of Heritage Impact*, prepared by Biosis, dated 20 March 2018) has indicated that there may be potential for archaeological deposits, they are not significant. The recommendation for an unexpected finds procedure is appropriate. No further heritage comments are required.
