FCNSW has no objection or comment on specifics of the extension project. Angus Place has a current Forest permit with FCNSW for surface infrastructure within Newnes State forest. Prior to any new infrastructure or other disturbance activity, Angus Place must submit a request to amend the permit and present all required documentation, including REFs and due diligence reports. The permit includes financial compensation for disturbance to the State forest and time to administer the permit.

Additionally, Angus Place should inform FCNSW if underground mining activities impact any surface roads or other infrastructure managed by FCNSW. Should the proposed extension impact any infrastructure managed by the FCNSW due to subsidence, a measure of compensation will be required to be paid to FCNSW at FCNSW's discretion.
