SECTION 4.55 APPLICATION – COMPRESSOR STATION INSTALLATION (MODIFICATION 1) – PUBLIC EXHIBITION

Dear Rose-Anne,

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) refers to the notification it received on 26 July 2021 regarding the above Section 4.55 application which has been referred for comment.

TfNSW has completed an assessment of the information provided (*APA East Coast Grid Expansion – Moomba to Wilton Pipeline – Modification Report 1*, Report No. J200919 RP11 prepared by EMM dated 12 July 2021 with associated attachments) and notes:

- the modification involves the installation of two compressor stations along the existing high-pressure gas pipeline at Lot 1 DP 580284 referred to as MW880 – Stage 1 and Lot 3 DP 593787 referred to as MW433 – Stage 2;
- the main traffic generation for both compressor stations will be during their construction. The submitted Traffic Impact Assessment (Report No. J200919 RP#6 Version v3 prepared by EMM dated 5 July 2021) indicating that this will generate up to a maximum of 62 daily vehicles movements at MW880 and 38 daily vehicles movements at MW433. Once operational both sites will generate up to 2 light vehicle trips per day as they are designed to operate unstaffed;
- there are no state classified roads near either site that will be adversely impacted by the proposal; and
- the applicant is proposing to implement several commitments as detailed in Section 6 of the submitted Traffic Impact Assessment (e.g. traffic management plans, obtaining permits for any oversized and overmass vehicles, etc).

Having regard to the above, TfNSW does not object to the submitted Section 4.55 application, in principle. TfNSW does however request the consent authority consider the points/suggested conditions outlined in **Attachment 1**.
