Thank you for your referral dated 29 July 2021 inviting comments from the Heritage Council of NSW on the above State Significant Development proposal.

In accordance with our previous correspondence (dated 25 March 2021) I reiterate that the subject site is not listed on the State Heritage Register (SHR), nor is it in the immediate vicinity of any SHR items. Further, the site does not contain any known historical archaeological relics. Therefore, no further heritage comments are required. The Department does not need to refer subsequent stages of this proposal to the Heritage Council of NSW.

Heritage NSW worked closely with DPIE in 2019 to establish criteria identifying when environmental heritage was a consideration for major projects and when it should be referred to the Heritage Council. You can find the referral criteria in the DPIE Assessment Practice Note 6. There is companion <u>heritage guidance for applicants</u> on the Major Projects website. This will assist you in understanding when the Heritage Council is likely to have an interest in any state significant projects.

As the site is in the vicinity of a local heritage item, advice should be sought from the relevant local council.
